DENTAL PROPHY ADMITTING FORM

Extraction & Elective Procedures Consent / Waiver

Many pets require sedation before a thorough examination can be completed. The condition of each tooth must be evaluated before a decision is made as to the best course of treatment. Although no one likes surprises, it is sometimes impossible to give an accurate estimate before sedation. It is much more safe and economical to complete all needed procedures during the initial dental rather than re-scheduling another appointment with additional sedation. **Please check ONLY ONE of the appropriate options below:**

- Please perform whatever procedures & extractions are required at this time.
- Please perform whatever procedures & extractions are required up to \$_____.
- Please do nothing more than the requested dental prophy procedure at this time.
- Please call me after the exam with an estimate if any additional procedures are needed. Do not proceed without authorization.*

*Please note that, in choosing this option, the procedure will **not** be done and pet will be allowed to wake up if you cannot be immediately reached at the phone number provided.

Elective Procedures to be done at same time

These are simple procedures that do not greatly increase anesthesia/sedation time and, therefore, can be done provides at a fee less than would be required otherwise (when sedation would be required for the separate procedure) when done at the same time as the dental prophy:

- Pain injection
- Comprehensive Physical Exam
- Ear Cleaning / Flushing
- Nail Trim
- Express Anal Glands
- Wart / Skin Growth Removal
- Vaccinations
- Flea and Tick Prevention – Frontline or Advantage
